WHAT IS ACT-YOU?

ACT-YOU is a European cooperation project bringing together youth workers, youth leaders, and organisations working with young people with fewer opportunities.

WHY THIS PROJECT?

Youth work plays a central role in participation, learning, and empowerment. At the same time, translating inclusive principles into everyday practice often presents concrete challenges. ACT-YOU was created to respond to these challenges by offering structured opportunities for professional development, peer exchange, and international cooperation, rooted in real experiences from different European contexts.



OUR OBJECTIVES

- inclusive youth work approaches;
- accessibility in youth work practice;
- communication and facilitation in professional youth work settings.

ACT-YOU translates these objectives into practice through activities that bring professionals together to learn from experience and exchange perspectives on their work.



THE PROJECT INCLUDES:

- a study visit in Belgium, where participants observe youth work in context and exchange experiences with partner organisations;
- a training course in Albania, focused on professional development and inclusive non-formal learning;
- a list of recommendations, gathering insights developed throughout the project.



As a result, ACT-YOU strengthens the capacities of youth workers and youth leaders, reinforces cooperation among organisations working with young people with fewer opportunities, and contributes to shared reflection on inclusive youth work at European level.
